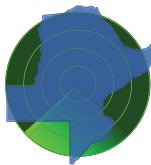

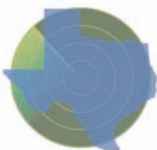
Join other TXWARN members from across Texas to learn how to use this important tool for water and wastewater restoration after a disaster.
